Acknowledgement to IGCSE-A Levels Exams

Respected Parents/Guardian,

Since PISJ CCS is a Cambridge accredited learning institute, this is, hereby, to inform you that as per school policy it is **mandatory** for all IGCSE-A level students to appear in CAIE Cambridge IGCSE-A levels Exams annually in May-June Series *(with due charges payable to Cambridge almost 3 months before CAIE Exams)* for all the chosen subjects that they have been learning at the school throughout the session(s). The purpose, of making students appear in maximum number of subjects, is to provide them maximum scoring opportunities to create a broader career scope, while on the other hand, **allowing students to appear in fewer subjects in CAIE exams could create challenges for them when applying in universities.**

Moreover, since **no annual school exams** are conducted for IGCSE/A Levels students, hence the only way for promotion to next grade levels is based on the Results of Cambridge IGCSE/A Levels Exams for the chosen subject group(s).

The school enrolls the **regular school candidates only** and does not enroll the private candidates nor does it register the regular students to appear as an external candidate.

The school enrolls all the regular students in the **May-June Exams Session** so the CAIE results will be declared before the start of the new academic session and the students may get promoted according to the declared results in the next grade level accordingly.

If any student(s) enrolls externally in any of the later Cambridge Exam Session other than May-June Session, the candidate(s) will not be able to resume the studies in next grade levels in the new academic session **until the results are declared for the later session**. Moreover, the candidate(s) must produce a result with A*-A in at least any 3 IGCSE subjects and shall be passed in remaining subjects.

If any regular student enrolls himself /herself externally in few selected subjects, the school will allow the student to continue in the next class **only if he/she fulfills the promotion criteria** i.e must produce a result with A*-A in at least any 3 IGCSE subjects and shall be passed in remaining subjects.

The CAIE IGCSE/AS Levels Exams usually are scheduled between the months of April-June. The date for opening of registration window for CAIE IGCSE/AS Levels Exams, fee structure as well as Exam dates shall be announced timely as soon as the updates from the British Council are received.

Parents must ensure that the **student's id/passport** must be valid at the time of CAIE Exams.
